VALLEJO COASTAL CLEANUP DAY
Saturday, September 17, 2005

Vallejo Sanitation & Flood Control District is proud to announce that the 21st annual California Coastal Cleanup Day will take place on Saturday, September 17 from 9 a.m. to noon at more than ten locations throughout Vallejo. Volunteers will clean trash and debris from creeks, lakes, marshes and shoreline throughout this area.

The 2005 Cleanup, the 13th in Vallejo and the 21st in the long history of the California Coastal Cleanup Day program, will see the ongoing expansion of the Cleanup. Each year, representatives from Vallejo Sanitation & Flood Control District and VALCORE Recycling visit potential cleanup sites. They match sites with volunteer Site Captains who lead crews at each site on the day of the event.

Volunteer Info

If you are interested in volunteering, either as a Site Captain or a member of the cleanup crews, you can contact any of the coordinators listed below. If you are under 18, you will need a parent or guardian to sign a waiver form before participating.

All cleanup supplies will be provided, but volunteers should wear sunscreen, sturdy shoes, a hat and gloves. When you check in at the cleanup location, you will be given trash bags, latex gloves and a data card to tally collected items.

VALLEJO: Volunteers are asked to meet at the Vallejo Marina at 42 Harbor Way at 8:30 a.m., where you will be assigned to a cleanup site. Or, you can register early and receive your site assignment by contacting Valcore at 55-EARTH (553-2784) or cleanup@Valcorerecycling.org. BENICIA: Volunteers can showup at 9:00 a.m. at the bottom of East Fifth, West H at West Third Cove, West Twelfth St. Beach, Willow Glen Park, the foot of First Street, the West Ninth Street beach, Lake Herman at Sulfur Springs Creek, the Bordoni public access area at West Sixth and I Sts., and two sites at Benicia State Recreation Area: West K at Military and the picnic area.
